Has been expelled in accordance with Section 37.007 during the preceding or current school year;	
Is currently on parole, probation, deferred prosecution, or other conditional release;	
Was previously reported through the Public Education Information Management (PEIMS) to have dropped out of school;	
Is a student of limited English proficiency, as defined by Section 29.052;	
Is in the custody or care of the Department of Protective and Regulatory Services or has, during the current school year, been referred to the department by a school official, officer of the juvenile court, or law enforcement official;	
Is homeless, as defined by 42 U.S.S. Section 11302, and its subsequent amendments; or	
Resided in the preceding school year or resides in the current school year in a residential placement facility in the district, including a detention facility, substance abuse treatment facility, emergency shelter, psychiatric hospital, halfway house, or foster group home.
